

3D SYLLABUS

Any Three-Dimensional Work
Pottery – Sculpture - Jewellery

Requirements for all submissions:

Submissions must be the **original creation of the submitter**. The work must be **three-dimensional** (sculpture, pottery, jewellery). The medium (clay, metal, glass, wood etc.) must be filled in on the entry form.

An artist statement of fewer than 75 words to explain the work, must be included on the entry form. A photograph, photocopy or sketch of the work must be included with the entry form, for identification purposes.

Adjudication

Critiques will be scheduled during Festival Week. Each entrant will be notified regarding their time(s) for adjudication. Times are posted in the pull-out program included in the local newspaper.

Artists are encouraged to attend their adjudication. Please notify the visual arts coordinator if you are unable to attend your adjudication time.

New – Collaboration Category

WP 2590

Any two or more artists from any visual arts discipline can combine to create a 2dimensional or 3 dimensional work. All entries in this category will be part of the Viewer's Choice awards and will be adjudicated by appropriate adjudicators.

Special requirements for Pottery:

Submissions must be **original** by the artist. The work must be clay or dominated by clay in the case of mixed media and there is no size restriction.

Functional pottery is a work that has a domestic use and would be considered safe for food use. Sculptural or decorative works do not have a

domestic use. Artists are limited to 2 entries in any one category to a maximum of 4 entries in the Pottery Show.

SCULPTURE

SC 5600 12 years of age and under

SC 5601 13-19 years of age

SC 5602 20 + years of age

Special requirements for Sculpture:

Maximum of 2 works. Must be **original** by the artist.

Must not exceed 3 x 3 ft. (90x90 cm) or exceed 50 lbs. (22.7 kilo)

Must be labeled with the artist's name, title of the piece and material used. Must be properly packaged for transport when delivered for exhibition.

JEWELLERY and ACCESSORIES

This category includes earrings, necklaces, bracelets, rings, cufflinks, brooches, purses, belts, hats and other items used to accessorize.
