WEARABLE ART

Any wearable garment from a changed or embellished pattern but made to enhance originality. Must include an artist's explanation of fewer than 75 words including fabric selection, technique used and design innovation.

A) Original garment. A garment from a changed or embellished pattern but made to enhance originality.

B) Recycled Denim. A wearable garment made wholly or partly from recycled denim.

QUILT ART

All entries must have a 4 inch (9 cm) hanging sleeve. Must include an artist's statement of fewer than 75 words including fabric selection, name of quilter (if different from piecer/designer), techniques used and design inspiration. Credit must also be given to the author, teacher or publisher for any piece made using a book, pattern or class.

A) Abstract Wall Quilts

Wallquilts exploring shapes, textures, colors, lines or suggesting inaccurate representations of people, places or objects and demonstrating personal expression and originality in design, color and/or technique.

B) Representational Wall Quilts

Wall quilts depicting landscapes, portraits and pictures that are fairly accurate and realistic. May be whole cloth, appliqué, collage and/or any combination of techniques.

C) Traditional Wall Quilts – Original Interpretation

Original interpretation based on traditional-style piecing and/or applique, using blocks and/or patterns in the public domain, with pleasing color combinations and approaches to combining the blocks.

D) Traditional Wall Quilts – From Patterns or Books

Wall quilts based on traditional-style piecing and/or appliqué, made from a published pattern or book with credit given to the author or publisher.

E) Bed Quilts

Bed quilts made to be used on a specific sized bed - crib to king.

INTERPRETIVE FABRIC ART

Interpreted piece from a pattern or original design that is neither wearable nor a quilt. eg. pillows, thread painting, dyed or painted fabric works etc.

NEEDLEWORK

A maximum of 2 works in each category.
Mounted, framed or on stretcher bars suitable for viewing by adjudicator.
Must include artists explanation of fabric selection, technique used and design innovation.

A) Counted Cross Stitch - A design produced by counting threads. Each stitch is taken over a definite number of threads evenly, using back stitch, cross stitch, four-sided stitch hem stitch and running stitch.

B) Crewel - Sometimes called Jacobean embroidery. A design worked using embroidery stitches using wool yarns.

C) Needlepoint - Stitches on openwork mesh canvas so canvas is completely covered.

D) Petit point - Needlepoint worked on fine yarn on very small single thread canvas usually 20 mesh to the inch or smaller.

E) Bargello - Long stitches on canvas in vertical stitches, forming peaks or points. Also called Flame work or Hungarian Point.

F) Black work - Black thread on white or cream linen, defining geometric designs. Stitches used are back, cross and running.

G) Cutwork - Parts of a design of embroidery are cut away before or after the motif had been embroidered.
